#### **Related Services Coordinator**

#### **Primary Function**

Administer, coordinate, and supervise Related Services, Section 504, and McKinney-Vento Homeless Act, and Health Services. Oversight of SEL curriculum and instruction and Discipline for PreK-8.

#### **Organizational Relationships**

The Related Services Coordinator reports to the Director of Special Services.

- 4. Remain current with legal requirements governing Special Education, Section 504, McKinney-Vento, and health services
- 5. Support building administrators with complex disciplinary issues, monitor out of school suspensions and report to Superintendent
- 6. Oversight of Threat Assessment process, documentation, and review process
- 7. Responsible for Annual Discipline Review Meeting
- 8. Provide oversight to school health practices including, but not limited to, Health Plans,
- 9. Life Threatening Food Allergy (LTFA) plans, and concussion protocols
- 10. Co-lead SEL MTSS in collaboration with the Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning
- 11. Oversight and implementation of Tier I SEL curriculum and instruction implementation and SEL interventions for Tier II and Tier III.
